<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▲ the yearly membership fee; ▲ mandatory French lessons: 15 lessons of 60 min / 15 hours per week and educational material. Maximum 15 students per class (see objectives and content on our website); ▲ full board accommodation in rooms with 2 to 4 beds (arrival on Sundays, departure on Saturdays); ▲ regular sports and cultural afternoon activities (not mandatory); Saturday's trip (except the one on departure Saturday) and a variety of evening entertainment activities (organized by the CMEF and its partners). The sample weekly program is non-binding. CMEF will always organize the best-quality activities, but given the broad range of available options, it might not be possible to participate in all of them during a single stay; ▲ 24-hour campus access control and night-time monitoring by professional security guards; ▲ camp staffers available 24/7; ▲ weekly laundry service; ▲ Wi-Fi access at the cafeteria; ▲ check-in and airport shuttle. The shuttle is free of charge from 8 am to 10 pm, 90 € extra outside these hours. CMEF cannot be held responsible for unforeseen adverse events that might delay the shuttle service. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▲ airfare to and/or from CMEF; ▲ travel and/or health insurance; ▲ the optional <i>Intensive French</i> lessons, 135 €/week; ▲ the 50 € security deposit to pay in cash upon arrival; ▲ the loss or repair of material lent to the camper during activities; ▲ les frais médicaux de médecin et de pharmacie ; ▲ an extra night with day excursion: 95 €; ▲ medical and pharmacy expenses; ▲ shuttle outside 8am/10pm transfer period: 90 €; ▲ bathroom towels are not provided.

APPLICATION FORM

It should include:

- ▲ the registration form filled out and signed;
- ▲ a deposit of 500 € via SEPA European bank transfer (net of bank charges).

Upon receipt of the deposit and this completed and signed registration form, an email will be sent (to the email address listed as primary) as well as access codes to your reserved web page: you will find practical information and forms to be filled in carefully (medical form with medical and liability insurance, scan of passport or identity card). Please note: registration will only be confirmed upon receipt of the balance and the information and documents required.

PAYMENT

All payments must be made via SEPA European bank transfer* or online payment by credit card at the end of the online registration. Total payment (handling fee deposit) must be made one month before the date of arrival.

CANCELLATION

The 500 € deposit will be retained by the Centre Méditerranéen d'Études Françaises. No refund will be made in case of cancellation less than one month before arrival, after the start of the course or on departures made before the end of the course. Once your child is at the centre no refund will be made upon cancellation of the optional afternoon course "Intensive French". The Centre Méditerranéen d'Études Françaises reserves the right to cancel summer program enrolment or the optional afternoon course, if the number of participants is insufficient or in case of majeure resulting in damages to the venue (fire, flash flood). In this case the registration fees will be fully refunded, not including travel costs (train, plane).

- ▲ *Cancellation of the stay due to force majeure*: should a language stay in our school need to be cancelled after it has been confirmed because of travel restrictions, lockdown, halt to transportation, proven symptoms COVID-19 in your son/daughter's (test results required) or any other epidemic/pandemic-related adverse change or event, no cancellation fees will be applied and deferred dates for the stay will be offered. If required, we will refund any paid installments (this does not include travel expenses).

INSURANCE

Participants must enter into an insurance contract in their own countries that includes: individual civil liability (for damage caused to third parties), medical insurance: sickness, accidents, hospitalization, repatriation, insurance for the practice of sports activities (check with your insurance company). CMEF highly recommends getting also covered against theft/loss of personal items and any sort of trip cancellation. The CMEF is not responsible for any thefts that take place in the Centre (mobile phones, laptops, tablets, etc.). We suggest you choose for your son/daughter a suitcase that can be locked.

CMEF's insurance covers only its own civil liability.

UNACCOMPANIED INDIVIDUAL OUTING

For ages 13 or older (although recommended for ages 14 or older). Possible from 1:30 PM to 6:30 PM with signed authorization from parents. In group of at least 3 teenagers. In this case, the Centre Méditerranéen d'Études

Françaises assumes no responsibility. We formally recommend that teenagers swim at beaches patrolled by lifeguards.

WATER ACTIVITIES

Your child can choose to participate - if he/she can swim (a swimming test will be performed the day after arrival) - in the following nautical activities supervised by instructors and our staff: sailing, paddling, banana boat, kayaking. With parental authorization.

These activities require your child to be in a normal physical condition. Please also make sure that your children are insured for the practice of such sport activities. With parental authorization.

INTERNAL RULES

(based on French legislation).

I hereby declare that I am aware of the general enrolment conditions, and that I have made my child aware of the rules and regulations of the CMEF according to French laws in force by which he/she must abide during his/her stay.

Formal prohibitions: regular and electronic cigarettes, alcohol, drugs, energy drinks, dangerous objects, such as knives, firecrackers, etc., use of fire, graffiti and other acts intended to damage the Centre, as well as on being out without a staff member after 6.30 pm and climbing trees.

Failure to comply with the rules, as well as any behavior deemed incompatible with the safety of participants or staff (alcohol, drugs, violence) will result in a penalty which may include the immediate exclusion of the participant without warning at the expense of their family and without refund for the remainder of the stay.

CMEF reserves the right to make and enforce other regulations during the vacation which are not included in the general conditions of enrolment, to safeguard the physical and moral welfare of the young people taking part.

French law requires that all participants have their original identity documents (passport or identity card) on-site (at CMEF). We will keep them safe.

The CMEF reserves the right to refuse the registration of a teenager whose behavior was judged unacceptable during a previous stay. In this case, any amount already paid will be refunded.

Security deposit: we kindly ask you to provide your son/daughter with an extra 50 € in his/her pocket money. It will be taken as a security deposit and given back on the day of departure, except in case of damage to the CMEF equipment..*

HEALTH

I authorize CMEF to take all measures necessary (medical examination, hospitalization) in case of emergency at CHPG Monaco or in a French hospital) to preserve the health or life of my child. In this case I agree to bear the medical expenses and hospitalization fees.

IMAGE REPRODUCTION RIGHT

CMEF carefully and respectfully selects and uses photos of the stays on its brochures and website for illustrative and marketing purposes. Stay participants (or their parents or legal representative) may request not to be depicted. Such requests must be submitted by priority mail by the day of arrival at the latest.

RGPD (GENERAL DATA PROTECTION REGULATION)

Personal data collected by CMEF is confidential and for the exclusive use of the school. The General Data Protection Regulation (RGPD) came into effect on May 25, 2018. This regulation aims to better protect individuals with respect to the processing of their personal data and to better define professional liability. Our association complies with this regulation. Stay participants' data is neither shared with nor sold to third parties.

COMPLAINTS

Nearly all practical problems that may arise during the stay are resolved immediately thanks to the permanent availability of direct verbal communication between the participants and the CMEF team. If despite repeated efforts of each one complaint persists, it should be made in writing to the direction of CMEF no later than one week after the end of the stay.
